They should also recognise skills instead of overly focusing on paper qualifications, says the Deputy Prime Minister.

..."At the end of the day, everyone is different, we are each **blessed with unique gifts and talents**. There's no need to compare with others." ...

...In his speech, Mr Wong also highlighted three challenges facing Singapore - **the future of work**, **the security of work and the rewards of work**. **The nature of jobs will change**, he stressed. "Those with the **right skills** will be able to seize the opportunities and enjoy tremendous rewards.

"These days, most workers now will have multiple careers in their lifetimes, even in the rare case of somebody working in the same company throughout their lives, the work they do will likely evolve over time," he observed. This means workers must be able to access skills training to update themselves and stay relevant, said Mr Wong.





#### GCE A-LEVEL CURRICULUM



There is flexibility and diversity in your choice of subject combinations with subjects offered at three levels of study – Higher 1 (H1), Higher 2 (H2) and Higher 3 (H3). 




