



Crucial with Recent Shifts in the Education System


- Nurturing students to learn for life





We aspire for every Yuhuan to learn for life. If we care for *self, others and the community*, we will:



Start Now: Set your targets


Questions to consider:

For both - you will also need to meet specific requirements based on your preferred course

Your ability to do well. This is not finite. The harder you work, the greater your potential grows.


Your performance is equal to what you are capable of when you remove distractions

What are your distractions?



- c) Their goals, dreams and aspirations






You are the most important people in your child's life – Influence them

- Attendance be <u>present</u> & <u>punctual</u> for school (Reporting time: Mon-Fri 7:30am, Wed 8:30 am)
- Attention monitor that he/she eats well and sleeps early so that he/she can focus on learning in class
- Attitude develop self-discipline and consistency (do homework, revise regularly, create study plan, submit assignments on time)

These are fundamental to flourish and achieve desired pathways in Upper Sec and beyond.
