The school came together strongly over the last 2 years, as we have a clear and bold vision to build **A Community Where Learners Flourish**. Learning continues despite all challenges, for it is our DNA as one community towards our mission to **Care, Connect and Contribute**. We are heartened that our vision and mission resonates strongly with students, staff, parents and the wider community. Indeed, we welcome a bumper cohort joining us at Sec One next year, with a full enrolment across all streams for every of the 8 new classes in 2022.

This resonance gives us great confidence and conviction to continue in building strong foundations, as we strengthen existing structures to help our students deepen their joy for learning through positive education, as well as continue in building a positive culture that encourages strong relationships between students and teachers.

At the heart of it all, our school believes that every Yuhuan can flourish – as long as each and every Yuhuan cherishes the importance of our school values of Curiosity, Adaptability, Respect, Responsibility, Resilience and Above All, CARE³. The pandemic has taught us many lessons, including the importance of developing self-motivated individuals who care not just about themselves, but are passionate to connect with others and issues, and with confidence, actively contribute to the good of others and society. This is only possible if we build each and every Yuhuan with a values-based education and with a strong Dare to CARE³.

Dare to CARE³ is our rallying theme as a school in 2022. To this end, our dedicated team of staff will work wholeheartedly with all students, parents and the greater community to boldly live out our values in nurturing a flourishing Yuhua. Whether it is during curriculum lessons, CCAs, Home-Based Learning Days, or in any other learning opportunity – we endeavour to help our students dig deeper to flourish by living out our values. Our primary goal to seed the right values of CARE³ will ensure that Yuhuans graduate with the right character to succeed in the future workplace and society.

I hope you are as excited as I am with 2022, and I look forward to your continued support and partnership in your child / ward's education journey at Yuhua Secondary. As we look ahead to the new academic year, the following are highlighted according to our various key priorities for your information:

1 Nurturing Flourishing Yuhuans Through Student Development

1.1 Keeping All Yuhuans Safe

a) Safe Management Measures for Start of 2022

Given the evolving COVID situation, we will remain vigilant and adhere to Safe Management Measures (SMMs) that have been put in place since 2021. These include the screening of all students, staff and visitors before being allowed entry, regular cleaning and disinfection of school premises.

To minimise intermingling on the first day of school, Sec 2 – 5 students will **report directly at their respective classrooms** for assembly and lessons (refer to **Annex A** for the layout of the school and the location of the classes). **Sec 1 students will report at the canteen on 4**th **Jan** where their form teachers will show them to their respective classrooms. From 5th Jan onwards, they can similarly report directly to their classrooms.

Recess timings and venues for different levels will be staggered to ensure that the canteen is not congested. Besides their assigned seats in the classrooms, Sec 1 and 3 students can have their food in the canteen during odd weeks, while Sec 2 and 4/5 students will do so on even weeks.

b) Trace Together Tokens

Students are **required to bring their Trace Together (TT) Tokens** to facilitate contact tracing. This is especially important as handphones are to be kept in personal lockers for safe-keeping during curriculum lessons. The TT tokens can be collected from any Community Centre/Club, and details can be found at token.gowhere.gov.sg.

c) Practise Good Personal Hygiene and Exercise Social Responsibility

Students should continue to practise good personal hygiene (e.g. regular handwashing) and exercise social responsibility (e.g. seeing a doctor and staying home if feeling unwell, wiping down of desk area and common/shared equipment after use). Students are reminded to keep to safe distancing guidelines, and the wearing of masks at all times. This is key to us living out our school's mission of Care, Connect and Contribute.

1.2 Looking Ahead to 2022

a) School Terms 2022

Please note the important dates regarding school terms in 2022 in the table below:

Parents are kindly requested to **refrain from taking your child away from school during term time** as that will affect his/her learning. Should there be special circumstances, please write to the school to seek advice from the School Leaders.

b) Reporting Times for School in 2022

Please be informed that reporting time to school will be **7.30am on all days for all cohorts in 2022**, except for **Wednesdays**, when the reporting time is at **8.30am**. Please encourage your child/ward to plan his/her journey well, and aim to be in school at least 10 minutes early, in case of traffic congestion. This will inculcate the habit of punctuality and ensure that there is no loss of curriculum time due to late-coming.

c) Start Right Programme

To prepare your child/ward for the new academic year, the school will be organising a Start Right programme on the first two days of Term 1, which will cover goal setting, academic and student development matters, as well as help strengthen peer and teacher relationships within their respective classes. On 4th January, students will be dismissed in a staggered manner by cohort from 1.20pm, and from 2.20pm on 5th January.

d) Co-Curricular Activities (CCA)

CCA for all students will formally commence on 11th January (Tuesday), while students involved in competition training may be called by their respective CCA teachers to start from the 7th January (Friday). CCA sessions will be conducted face to face with Safe Management Measures to provide students with the opportunity to connect and nurture their interests and talents beyond the academic curriculum.

1.3 Developing Self Discipline and Responsibility

a) Punctuality and Attendance

Beyond punctuality, we also seek your support to monitor your child's/ward's attendance closely, and ensure he/she does not stay away from school without valid reason. Absenteeism should be substantiated with **medical certificates only**. Students who are absent without valid reasons will face serious disciplinary consequences as outlined in the Student Handbook.

b) Dress Code

To help all Yuhuans cope with heat and wearing of face masks, we will continue to allow students to report in the school polo shirt. Yuhuans are reminded to maintain proper attire with formal school skorts / shorts / pants, as well as white socks and black shoes. Please ensure your child come to school with proper grooming, displaying their daily readiness to learn.

c) Responsible Use of Mobile Phones & Personal Learning Devices

As a school, our mission is to build students who care, connect and contribute to each other's learning and growth. To minimise distractions to learning, students are to ensure that their handphones and electronic gadgets are switched off and kept in their lockers except when required for lessons or during break times. To ensure a conducive learning environment for all, handphones will be confiscated if they are in-appropriately used.

Yuhuans are also reminded to exercise responsible use of their Personal Learning Devices (PLDS) both in class and beyond curriculum time. Devices should **be fully charged before the start of each school day** and be kept safely in lockers when not required for lessons. PLDs should be used primarily for learning and we urge parents to journey closely with your children to manage their screen time at home judiciously.

2 Nurturing Flourishing Yuhuans Through Teaching and Learning

2.1 Assessment Structure in Yuhua Secondary School

In alignment with MOE's focus on holistic learning and to provide time and space for our students to engage in deep learning, our school will not be having Mid-Year Exams for all Sec 1, 2 and 3 students.

With the removal of Mid-Year exams, this will free up about three weeks of curriculum time for each level each year. This will allow our teachers to better pace out meaningful teaching and learning, leveraging engaging pedagogies to deepen understanding and develop 21st century competencies in our students.

The school will conduct no more than one Weighted Assessment per subject per term in addition to Mid-Year (MYE) / End of Year Examinations (EYE) where applicable, and continue to leverage formative assessment to provide feedback and enhance teaching and learning. The relative weighting for each assessment is summarized in the following table, and students will be informed of the requirements of each assessment task by their subject teachers nearer the dates.

2.3 Home Based Learning 2022

As announced by MOE in Dec 2020, the school seek to build greater self-directedness and motivation in our students by making Blended Learning (a mix of home-based and in-school activities) a key feature of the secondary school learning experience.

Every Even Week Friday, the school will be enacting a different timetable to prepare our students for Blended Learning.

For the first two Even Week Fridays of 2022, workshops will be run in school to build in Yuhuans skills and dispositions towards purposeful self-directed learning. These include workshops related to ICT baseline skills, cyber-wellness, self-directed learning, as well as self-study strategies.

These workshops will set our students up well for actual Home Based Learning (HBL) days that will be scheduled for Even Week Fridays for the rest of the year. On these days, students will report online for their daily check-in with their form class and be attired in half-uniform (Blue school Polo-Tee and school skorts/shorts/long pants) as we show our readiness to learn as one Yuhua. We seek your close partnership in this endeavour, and more information will be provided nearer to the date.


