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WELCOME MESSAGE BY PRINCIPAL FOR TERM 1 2024

On behalf of the school, my warmest greetings to all! I hope all Yuhuans had a wonderful break with family, all ready to start a new school year. To all our new Secondary One students and family looking forward to the new adventure in Yuhua Secondary: my heartiest welcome!

For Yuhuans who have been here for a number of years, you would know that I start every year with a new rallying theme. The rallying theme is one to unify and to give each and every one of us a common purpose, as we gather as one school and to help every Yuhuan in the community learn and flourish.

This aligns with our school vision – **A Community Where Learners Flourish**. 1 <u>Nurturing Flourishing Yuhuans Through Student Development</u>

1.1 Looking Ahead to 2024

a) School Terms 2024

Please note the important dates regarding school terms in 2024 in the table below:

Parents are kindly requested to **refrain from taking your child away from school during term time** as that will affect his/her learning. Should there be special circumstances, please write to the school to seek advice from the School Leaders.

b) Reporting and Break Times in 2024

Please be informed that reporting time to school will be **7.30am on all days**, except for **Wednesdays**, when the reporting time is adjusted slightly to **8.25am**. Please encourage your child/ward to plan his / her journey well and aim to be in school at least 10 minutes early in case of traffic congestion. This will inculcate the habit of punctuality and ensure that there is no loss of curriculum time due to late-coming.

We have adjusted the timetables for 2024, to **periods of 35 minutes length**. This will allow all students to have **35 minutes for recess and lunch break each day**, thus having sufficient time to eat and rest in between lessons.

c) Class Names and Venues for 2024

The names of our classes are based on our school values (CARE³), the 3Cs of Care, Connect and Contribute, and our vision for every Yuhuan to 'Flourish'. Please refer to **Annex B** on the locations of the various classrooms for next year.

d) Start Right Programme

To prepare your child/ward for the new academic year, the school will be organising a Start Right programme on the first day of Term 1, which will cover academic and student development matters, as well as help strengthen peer and teacher relationships within their respective classes. On 2nd January, students will be dismissed by cohort at **12.40pm**.

1.2 Developing Self Discipline and Responsibility

a) Punctuality and Attendance

Beyond punctuality, we also seek your support to monitor your child's/ward's attendance closely, and ensure he/she does not stay away from school without valid reason. Absenteeism should be substantiated with **medical certificates only, unless otherwise approved due to special circumstances**. Students who are absent without valid reasons will face serious disciplinary consequences as outlined in the Student Handbook.

b) Dress Code

Students are to report in formal white uniform on Mondays, and are free to wear the school polo shirt for other days of the week. Yuhuans are reminded to maintain proper attire with formal school skorts / shorts / pants, as well as white socks and black shoes. Please ensure your child come to school with proper grooming, displaying their daily readiness to learn.

c) Responsible Use of Mobile Phones & Personal Learning Devices (PLDs)

As a school, our mission is to build students who care, connect and contribute to each other's learning and growth. To minimise distractions to learning, students are to ensure that their handphones and electronic gadgets are switched off and kept in their lockers except when required for lessons or during break times. To ensure a conducive learning environment for all, handphones will be confiscated if they are inappropriately used.

Yuhuans are also reminded to exercise responsible use of their Personal Learning Devices (PLDs) both in class and beyond curriculum time. Devices should **be fully charged before the start of each school day** and be kept safely in lockers when not required for lessons. PLDs should be used primarily for learning and we urge parents to journey closely with your children to manage their screen time at home judiciously.

2 <u>Nurturing Flourishing Yuhuans Through Teaching and Learning</u>

2.1 Assessment Structure in Yuhua Secondary School

In alignment with MOE's nationwide focus on holistic learning and to provide time and space for our students to engage in deep learning, Mid-Year Exams have been removed for all levels from 2023.

With the removal of Mid-Year exams, this will free up more curriculum time for each level. This will allow our teachers to better pace out meaningful teaching and learning, leveraging engaging pedagogies to deepen understanding and develop 21st century competencies in our students.

The school will conduct no more than one Weighted Assessment per subject per term and continue to leverage formative assessment to provide feedback and enhance teaching and learning. The weighting for each assessment is summarized in the following table, and students will be informed of the requirements of each assessment task by their subject teachers nearer the dates.






SCHOOL LAYOUT
