MESSAGE BY PRINCIPAL FOR START OF TERM 3 2024

1.1 Value of the Term: Respect

2.1 Blended Learning for Semester 2

Even week Fridays are no longer HBL days in Semester 2 and students will be required to come to school for lessons on all Fridays.
